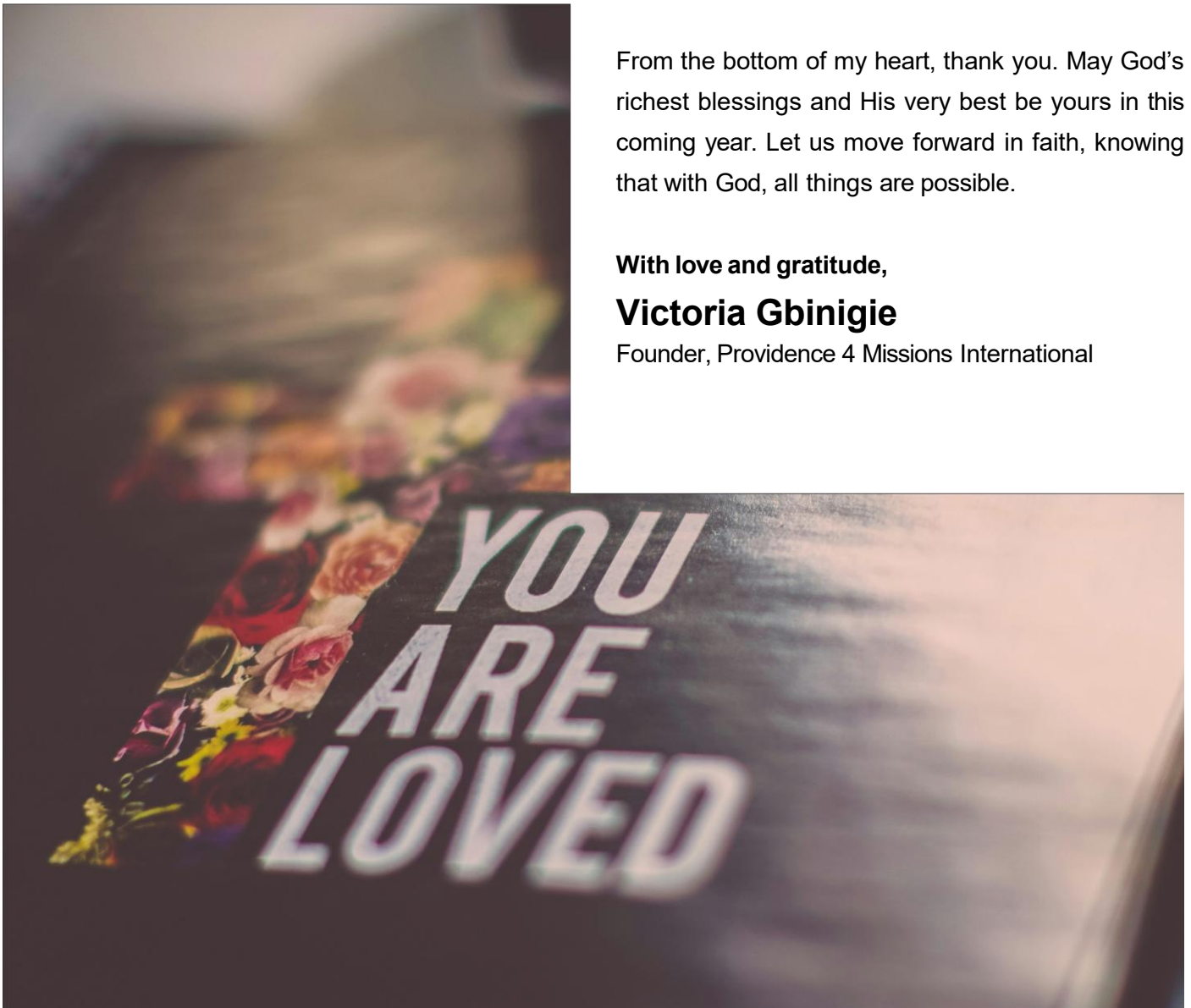

Our Story

A Journey of Purpose



*In early 2018, while reading **Revolutions in Missions** by Yolanda Adams, God gave me the vision for **Providence 4 Missions** and instructed me that it was time to act.*



Providence 4 Missions International was established as a divine calling, born from the heart of God. The journey began in 1994 in Lagos, Nigeria. At the time, I had the opportunity to move abroad for work. During a send-off prayer meeting organized by a group of friends, God revealed that He was sending me abroad for a purpose He had prepared, though He did not provide any further details at that moment.

Since then, my journey has taken me across different countries, including Trinidad and Tobago, the United Kingdom, and now Canada. Throughout these years, I lived with the certainty that God had a mission for me, even though I did not yet understand its full scope.

Like Moses, I initially felt inadequate for the task ahead, but God assured me that He would bring people to support and accomplish His purpose. That promise has continually been fulfilled, and I trust it will remain so in the future because this mission is ultimately His, not mine.

Providence 4 Missions was officially incorporated as a provincial non-profit organization in Saskatchewan on January 1, 2019. The organization later became a federally incorporated non-profit on October 4, 2021, and was granted charitable status on March 1, 2022.

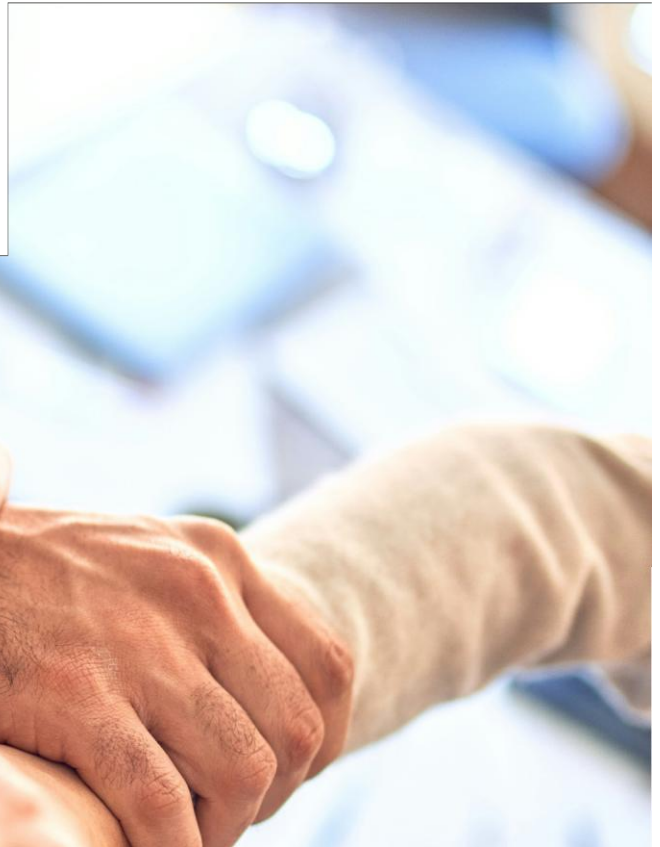

2024 Program Activities & Community Engagement Highlights

Providence 4 Missions (P4M) is committed to fostering connections, supporting missionaries, and partnering with local churches and ministries to advance God's mission. Below is a summary of our key activities and partnerships for 2024:



01 Church Engagement and Partnerships

Building relationships with churches remains a cornerstone of our mission work. In 2024, P4M conducted several church visits to raise awareness of our mission and explore partnerships:

■ **February 2024**

Engaged with the church communities and shared P4M's mission work directly with the pastor.

02 Pastoral and Ministry Networking

P4M intentionally seeks to build strong pastoral relationships to foster collaboration and mutual support:



■ **February 2024** - An opportunity to share our vision and provide support at a Pastor's social lunch

■ **February 2024** Participated in a community outreach activity, restocking the University of Regina's community fridge demonstrating shared values of serving the city's vulnerable populations.

03 Missionary Support

We remain committed to supporting missionaries in the field through financial assistance, skills development, and relational care:



- **December 2023 – May 2024: Initial Support for Missionary in Turkey A.D through ACCI Canada:** Provided monthly ministry contributions over a six-month period in support of his ongoing missionary endeavours.
- **June 2024 – November 2024: Second Round of Support for A.D** Continued with monthly missionary support for another six months, ensuring sustained impact.
- **June 2024: English Tutoring Support for A.D -** Experienced ESL teacher, began virtual English lessons to equip his ministry for broader engagement in his mission field.



04 Ministry Outreach Support

P4M values supporting local ministries that align with our mission, particularly those focused on university student outreach:

- **April 2024 – September 2024-** Provided monthly grant support over a six-month period to enhance outreach efforts to university students. This support contributed to evangelism initiatives and community care activities among the student population.

05 Training and Capacity Building

We invested in the development of our leadership and administrative team through formal mission training:

- **April 17 – May 25, 2024- Kairos Mission Training Course:** Sponsored six participants for a 6-week mission training course, strengthening our team's capacity to engage effectively in mission work.

06 Partnership and Event Sponsorships

We contributed to mission-aligned events and activities that foster community outreach and evangelism:

- **May 2024- Donation to Gospel Fire for All Nations:** Provided financial support for the “Come Together” Outreach Event held at Mosaic Stadium in Regina, Saskatchewan. This initiative aimed to share the gospel with a wide and diverse community audience.

07 Fundraising & Community Engagement Events

To support our growing mission efforts, P4M initiated grassroots fundraising and awareness events:

- **July 2024 - Movie Night Fundraiser:** A community-focused event held in Regina to raise awareness and support for P4M’s mission. The evening provided an opportunity to engage attendees with our work in a relaxed and inviting setting.
- **September 2024- Mini Worship Night Fundraiser:** An inspiring evening of worship and community, held to raise support for P4M’s ongoing mission and programs.

Building a Church in Turkey: A Story of Perseverance and Hope

(Names have been concealed for security reasons. Ministry in Turkey remains sensitive, as it is a secular country where following Christ often comes with challenges.)

One of the most significant milestones has been the remarkable growth of our beneficiary's Instagram outreach. In under a year, the account has become the largest Turkish Christian presence on the platform, reaching over 500,000 people and gaining 4,600 followers. Through this digital ministry, many individuals have been introduced to the message of Jesus, some beginning with curiosity and eventually coming to faith.

In addition to the social media impact, two online discipleship groups; one for men and one for women have been launched. These groups serve as safe, vibrant communities where believers can connect, encourage one another, and boldly share the Gospel. For many who feel isolated in their faith, these groups have become a crucial source of fellowship and support.

Our beneficiary serving in Turkey continues to witness God's hand at work, both in times of challenge and in moments of breakthrough.

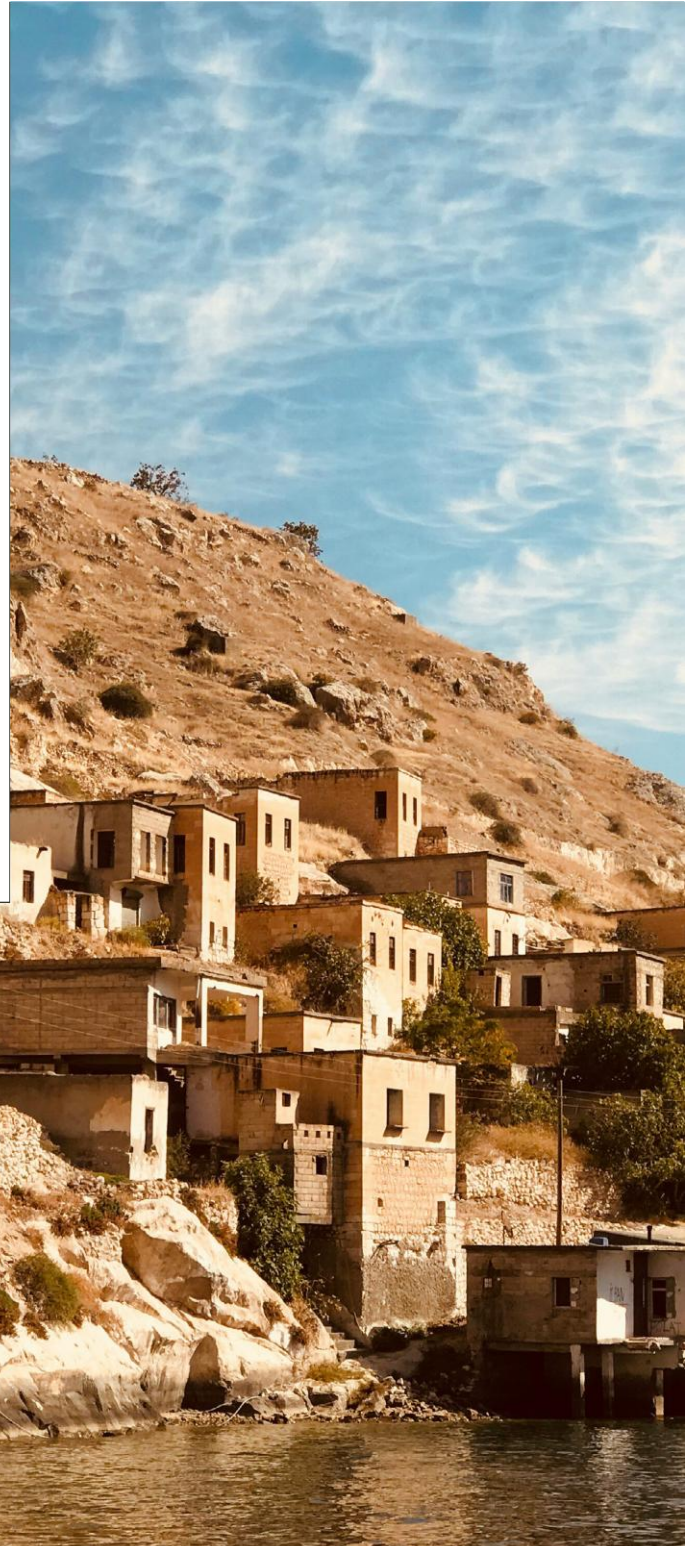


A growing church of approximately ten members continues to navigate complex dynamics. The recent addition of an older pastor has brought some positive momentum, and while progress is evident, the congregation remains in prayerful pursuit of greater unity through God's Spirit to strengthen their collective service.

Beyond leadership challenges, this church is also facing political divisions and sectarian tensions, as members from various backgrounds, including Catholic and Orthodox visitors, seek spiritual community. Despite these obstacles, our beneficiary faithfully encourages the congregation to focus on Christ's unity. Two new believers have recently come to faith; a young man with a servant's heart and another who is demonstrating encouraging signs of spiritual growth. As they continue to be discipled, both have the potential to become influential leaders in the church in Turkey.

Additionally, two young members will attend a Christian youth camp, and the church hopes this will deepen their faith. In a neighboring city, baptism courses began this summer, though attendance was limited due to seasonal challenges. Plans are underway to restart in October. Our beneficiary also shared and reconnecting with friends and believers, and finding personal refreshment and renewed vision.

In the wake of the devastating earthquake two years ago, efforts to provide trauma counseling are now taking shape. A trained counselor will begin serving there in October, and our beneficiary will help support this ministry both in person and online. Another highlight is seeing a former disciple recently appointed as a pastor, a joyful reminder of the long-term fruit of faithful mentoring.

Finally, practical needs weigh heavily. Due to a lack of transportation, traveling between cities for ministry takes up to four hours each way, limiting time with church members and making home visits nearly impossible. Through these stories, we see both the deep needs and the incredible perseverance of those serving in Turkey. Please join us in praying for unity in the church, spiritual growth among new believers, effective trauma counseling outreach, and provision for critical transportation needs.

Impact Story: Reaching the Unreached in Turkey



Our beneficiary in Turkey has been steadfast in serving across multiple cities, despite facing significant personal challenges. Over the past year, he traveled extensively to encourage local believers, particularly on the anniversary of the devastating earthquake. His commitment to the Gospel remains unwavering, even in the face of adversity.

He has been actively building relationships with new people and is currently discipling three new believers. Additionally, he is in the process of developing a foundational Christian training course for these new followers of Jesus. He continues to pray for more hearts to be open to the Gospel, while also providing practical assistance and creating opportunities to share the love of Christ within his community and family.

Despite personal and financial challenges, this beneficiary continues to serve boldly, witnessing healing miracles, engaging in street evangelism, and building community both online and in person. He has asked for continued prayers for health, financial provision, and for the many people hearing the Gospel through these efforts.

Enrich Life Church: Raising Up the Next Generation of Leaders

September is always a busy time for Enrich Life Church, a ministry we support at Providence 4 Missions, as they connect with new students during Welcome Week at the University of Regina. This past year was especially significant as they navigated a leadership transition. Founding pastor, relocated to a new community, with a new pastor stepping in to fill his position, showing a clear sign of God’s provision for this community.

Despite the transitions, Enrich Life Church continued to thrive. They hosted a Welcome Week Pizza Party, handed out grocery hampers to students in need, and gathered 41 people for a worship night right on campus. That night led to at least one student beginning a new relationship with Jesus. Throughout the year, they maintained regular gatherings, built relationships, and mentored emerging leaders in organic and impactful ways.

On reflection in his final year, the lead pastor shared *“This is why God planted this ministry, to raise up and disciple Christian leaders who can share the gospel and find confidence in their faith.”*

We are honoured to support ministries like Enrich Life Church, who are reaching students, building community, and raising leaders to carry the message of Jesus forward.

2. PURPOSE OF THE ORGANIZATION

Providence 4 Missions International Inc. (the "Organization") is a not-for-profit organization incorporated federally under the Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act. As a registered charity the Organization is exempt from the payment of income tax under Section 149(1) of the Income Tax Act.

The Organization operates to:

 - Support and maintain missions and missionaries in order to propagate the Christian faith.
 - Promote health, advance education and relieve poverty by providing medical devices, need-based scholarship for elementary, secondary, or postsecondary education, and food, clothing and shelter for Christian preachers and pastors, and their families who are in need.
 - Advance education by providing leadership training programs to Christian Church Leaders.
 - Undertake activities ancillary and incidental to the attainment of the above charitable purposes.
