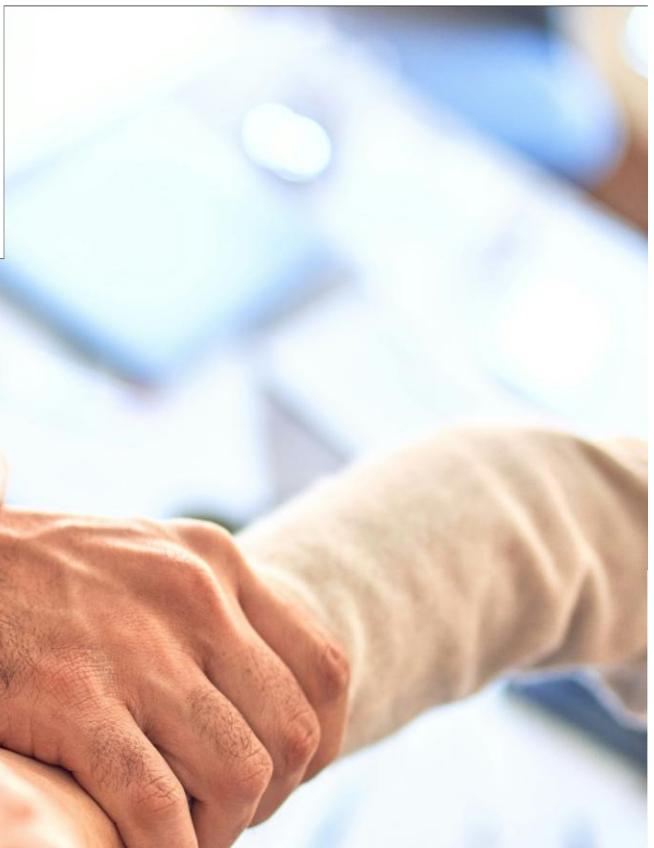

01 Volunteer and Partners Breakfast Meeting

- **March 2025**

2. PURPOSE OF THE ORGANIZATION

PURPOSE OF THE ORGANIZATION

Providence 4 Missions International Inc. (the "Organization") is a not-for-profit organization incorporated federally under the Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act. As a registered charity the Organization is exempt from the payment of income tax under Section 149(1) of the Income Tax Act.

The Organization operates to:

- a. Advance the teachings of the Christian faith and the religious tenets, doctrines, observances and culture associate with that faith.
 - b. Support and maintain missions and missionaries in order to propagate the Christian faith.
 - c. Promote health, advance education and relieve poverty by providing medical devices, need-based scholarship for elementary, secondary, or postsecondary education, and food, clothing and shelter for Christian preachers and pastors, and their families who are in need.
 - d. Advance education by providing leadership training programs to Christian Church Leaders.
 - e. Undertake activities ancillary and incidental to the attainment of the above charitable purposes.
